
Happy New Year 2020! May we create true wellness this decade through fitness, nutrition, environmental and social wellness and may the very best be yet to come. Be Well!

January-March CSR: Dallas Children's Advocacy Center

1 in 10 children will be sexually assaulted before the age of 18. <u>Dallas Children's Advocacy Center(DCAC)</u> coordinates the investigation, prosecution and healing services for the most severe cases of child abuse in Dallas County - those that rise to the level of a criminal offense.

This year, DCAC served over 7,000 children (and their non-offending family members) who were sexually abused, severely physically abused, or who had witnessed a violent crime. DCAC's average client is a 9-year-old girl, sexually abused by someone she knows and trusts. Help DCAC save the "Jane Does" and "John Does" experiencing abuse.


