Speakers Showcase

Linda Hill's program for the May 22nd MPI meeting featured a showcase of four dynamic speakers from the North Texas Speakers Association. The first was Robert Handley, president of Robert Handley Associates and the current president of NTSA. Bob is a professional speaker, educator, consultant in the fields of stress management and motivation, and author of a best selling book "Anxiety and Panic Attacks. Their Cause and Cure." He addressed the problems of stress as a national epidemic which is very costly to companies and individuals in terms of stress disorders and in relationships. With 50% of all illnesses being stress related, we must learn how to take control over our lives to manage stress.

The next speaker, Stan White, is a humorist who used humor to open our minds for an inspirational and motivational message that the good old days are today. In a drawing after the program, copies of Stan's tape "Laugh and Live" were given out to four lucky MPI attendees.

Suzanne Boswell, president of Suzanne Boswell Image Consultants specializing in seminars and workshops on image, appearance and non-verbal communication, followed with a demonstration of the nonverbal communications that are sent by our clothing. Although she directed her presentation toward the men in the group, it was easy for everyone to see how a positive image can impact our credibility. People believe the nonverbal message first and are confused when we send conflicting messages. Suzanne dramatically demonstrated how credibility changes and that we come across more strongly when verbal and nonverbal messages are the same.

The last speaker was Jane Warfford who is vice president of Career Development Services, Inc. and Feedback Services, Inc., and has been appointed by Governor White to be Chairperson of the Human Relations Speaker Bureau of Texas. Jane conducts seminars and keynote speeches on customer service and personal motivation. She demonstrated to our group the affects and importance of the ways we greet people, followed by a very inspirational message to look inside ourselves beyond the external "scars".

Congratulations go to Linda Hill for a super meeting, and judging from the report cards, one of the best. Congratulations also go to the door prize winner, Ellie Driver of Hershey Hotels, who won a night on the town for two in Fort Worth from the Fort Worth Convention and Visitors Bureau. 


